

ASCN UK Vice Chairperson Roles & Responsibilities

- Deputise for Chairperson when necessary – supporting and advocating the role of the chairperson.
- Promote the philosophy, mission and values of the association both ASCN UK nationally and internationally.
- Ensure all decisions are made in alignment with the current ASCN UK Constitution.
- Act as ambassador for the association and promote ASCN UK nationally and internationally.
- Take the lead in communications for consultations e.g. DoH/NHSE with the other Committee members or delegate as appropriate and agreed by committee.
- Support working parties and research projects within ASCN UK on a national basis.
- Take responsibility for updating ASCN UK constitution as required and liaising with Charity Commission and secretariat.
- Participate in national initiatives/projects to represent the stoma care speciality thereby providing an informed clinical voice on behalf of people living with a stoma and specialism nationally.
- Collaborate with committee and secretariat/conference organisers in planning annual National Conference.
- In collaboration with committee members progress and move the association forward, to meet the needs of the UK members, national trends and policies in Stoma Care.
- In collaboration with the committee members; build and maintain relationships with other organisations, healthcare professionals and stakeholders in the healthcare field to foster collaboration.
- Contribute to pre-election meeting with applicants for in committee positions.
- Chairperson must be informed in advance of unavailability (e.g. holidays).
- Support all aspects of ASCN UK in the running of the Association, attending meetings wherever possible and responding to emails in a timely manner.
- In collaboration with the committee members ensure all decisions are made in alignment with the current ASCN UK Constitution.
